




Clothes in summer




Most children wear T-shirts, shoes, and trousers in summer.



5. Next to the child with blue trousers is a child with red trousers.




Pencil cases




All children have pencil cases at school.

5. A blue rubber is in the orange pencil case.




Toys




Three children have toys on shelves in their rooms. They all have balls, skipping ropes, dolls, and teddies.
Read, colour, and find out:


