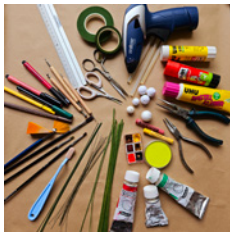

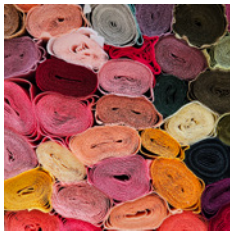

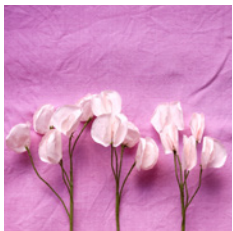

My paper flower journey started with folding origami flowers and simple paper flowers with instructions from the internet. Then, one birthday,
